PASTOR'S CORNER

TRANSFORMED TO BECOME " REPAIRERS AND RESTORERS" (Isaiah 58:11)

Isaiah 58:11 is a powerful promise which speaks of God's unfailing guidance and provision for His people. As we turn our hearts and minds to a powerful promise found in this text, it is pertinent to note that before the wonderful promises found in the well-watered garden image that God's first concern for the saints is for them to know that there is an eternal connection between righteousness and blessedness.

The reason why the prophet is called to "cry aloud, and spare not, (but) to lift up his voice like a trumpet," is to show those who pass for God's people that, if they have nothing better to bring to the heart-searching God than hollow phrases, formal services, outward actions which are not animated by inward feeling, they are living in transgression and in sin (ver. 1).

Though God promises to make us like watered gardens, the living water that flows out of us—believers is expected to bring life to those around us. We are called to be repairers of the breach, the restorer of the streets to live in!
